IT GROWS WELL THROUGH THE COOL MONTHS OF FALL AND EARLY SPRING, BUT WILL BOLT AND GO TO SEED WHEN THE WEATHER TURNS WARM. LET IT FLOWER AND FADE BEFORE REMOVING IT AND IT WILL SELF-SOW, GIVING YOU MORE PLANTS TO WARM YOUR NEXT COOL-SEASON.
