## CARYOPTERIS INCANA

THOUGH OBVIOUSLY RELATED TO ITS LARGER, MORE UPRIGHT RELATIVE, THE NATURALLY HYBRIDIZED BLUEBEARD (CARYOPTERIS X CLANDONENSIS), JUST ABOUT EVERYTHING ABOUTTHIS AUTUMN BLOOMING SHRUB IS MORE COMPACT AND DENSE. AUTUMN BLUE HAS A LOWER BROADER PROFILE AND A LESS OPEN FORM. REACHING 2-3-TALL X 3-4 WIDE, IT FILLS IN AROUND THE FEET OF TALLER GROWING SHRUBS AND PERENNIALS. THE FLOWERS. APPEARING IN LATE SUMMERINTO FALL, ARE LINED UP ON FOOTLONG BLOOMING STEMS, AND ARE ARRANGED LIKE-TIGHT, FUZZY, BLUE POM-POMS ON A STRING ITS LATE BLOOMTIME, AT ATTIME WHEN MANY GARDEN PLANTS HAVE SLOWED OR STOPPED THEIR BLOOMING, IS A BONUS FORTHE BUTTERFLIES THAT LOVE TO SIP ITS NECTAR AUTUMN BLUE SPIREA WITHSTANDS POOR, DRY SOIL AND IS RESISTANT TO THE BROWSING OF DEER
