COREOPSIS VERTICILLATA MOONBEAM

ANOTHER DECEPTIVE PLANT WITH A DELICATE APPEARANCE AND A TOUGH NATURE, MOONBEAM FORMS HUNDREDS OF SOFTYELLOW FLOWERS ATOP AN 18" MOUND OF THREADLIKE FOLIAGE. THE LOOK IS WONDERFULLY AIRY BUTTHE PLANTITSELF IS MUSCULAR; DROUGHT TOLERANT, DEER RESISTANT (MUCH MORE SO THAN BROAD LEAFED COREOPSIS GRANDIFLORA!), TOLERANT OF POOR SOILS, LONG LIVED, AND A VERY LONG BLOOMER WITH A FLOWER COLOR SO EASY TO COMBINE WITH OTHER COLORS, THIS PLANT IS A WINNER FOR MIXED CONTAINERS OR BORDERS. REMOVE SPENT FLOWERS TO KEEP THE PLANT IN BLOOM AND YOU'LL HAVE A CONTINUOUS BLOOM PERIOD FROM EARLY SUMMERTHROUGH FALL
