REBLOOMS UNTIL FROST, REMOVE SPENT SEED HEADS TO KEEPTHE BLOSSOMS COMING, BUTDON'T FORGETTO LEAVE PLENTY STANDING JUST BEFORE THE PLANT GOES DORMANT FORTHE WINTER BIRDS WILL VISITTHEM THROUGHTHE WINTERTO ENJOYTHE SEEDS. MAKES A GREAT CUT FLOWER DROUGHT TOLERANT, CLAY TOLERANT AND GENERALLY LEFT ALONE BY DEER
