## FAWN LILY ERATHRONIUM PAGODA'

THE DELIGHT OF SPRINGTIME WILDFLOWER SEEKERS, THE FAWN LILY (ORTROUTLILY, OR DOG TOOTH VIOLET) IS A CALIFORNIA NATIVE BULBTHAT FORMS COLONIES OF BROAD-LEAFED SPRINGTIME EPHEMERALS IN OPEN WOODLANDS AND MEADOWS. THE NODDING, PALE SULFUR COLORED BLOSSOMS ARE GORGEOUS AND GRACEFUL IN THE FILTERED SUNLIGHT, AND BRIGHTEN THE SHADOWIEST OF SPOTS. PAGODA' IS A HYBRID BETWEEN OUR OWN ERYTHRONIUM TUOLUMNENSE (ENDEMICTO TUOLUMNE COUNTY AND LISTED AS RARE AND ENDANGERED) AND ERYTHRONIUM CALIFORNICUM, SELECTED FORTTS VIGOR AND EASE OF CULTURE. WHERE HAPPY, IN MOIST, ORGANIC SOIL, IT WILL SPREAD RAPIDLY, BECOMING A LARGER DISPLAY YEAR AFTER YEAR DEER RESISTANT AND TOLERANT OF DROUGHT DUE TO SUMMER DORMANCY.
