ATTRACTIVE TO BUTTERFLIES AND BEES, THE SEED HEADS, ATTRACTIVE IN THEIR OWN RIGHT, ARE ALSO ENJOYED BY BIRDS. 1 1/2-3 FEETTALL AND WIDE IN BLOOM, THE REDDISH PURPLE DOME-TOPPED BUTTON BLOOMS SITUPON WIRY STEMS, APPEAR OVER A LONG SEASON IN SUMMER, AND ARE GOOD FOR CUT FLOWERS. TRY WITH ORNAMENTAL GRASSES FOR A STUNNING DISPLAY, GREAT OLD-FASHIONED PERENNIAL FOR WILDFLOWER
