WHAT A FLOWER COLOR! LONG BLOOMING BEAUTOLAIS IS VERY ATTRACTIVE TO BUTTERFLIES AND MAKES AN EXCELLENT CUTFLOWER TOLERANT OF HEAVY SOILS, EVENTHOSE-THAT STAY WET, THIS LOOSESTRIFE IS NOT TO BE CONFUSED WITH PURPLE LOOSESTRIFE (LYTHRUM SALICARIA) AND DOES NOT HAVETHAT PLANT'S INVASIVE QUALTITES. INSTEAD, IT FORMS A SLOWLY SPREADING CLUMP, IDEAL FOR PLANTING NEAR WATER FEATURES OR STREAMS. AND AS IF THE SUMMER LONG BLOOM TIME OF ELEGANT, WINE COLORED FLOWERS WEREN'T ENOUGH, THE SILVERY FOLIAGE LOOKS LOVELY IN THE SHADY AREASTHIS PLANT PREFERS GORGEOUS!
