THIS CALIFORNIA NATIVE PLANTIS BOTH DEER AND DROUGHT-TOLERANT AND REQUIRES LITTLE MORETHAN WELL DRAINING SOILTO FLOURISH. MINIMAL SUMMER WATER IS REQUIRED FORTHIS BEAUTY, AS OVER-WATERING IS ITS NEMESIS, BUT PROVIDE OCCASIONAL, MODERATE(!) SUMMER WATER TO KEEP IT AT ITS BEST. BEST IN PARTIAL SHADE IN HOTCLIMATES, IT DOES WELL TOGETHER WITH SUCCULENTS IN A ROCK GARDEN OR POTWHERE DRAINAGE IS ENHANCED. STUNNING!
