FIRECRACKER PENSTEMON IS A DROUGHT TOLERANT, HUMMINGBIRD ATTRACTING NATIVE PENSTEMONTHAT NATURALLY OCCURS IN THE SEMI-DESERT PINYON PINE FORESTS OF THE WEST. ITS SHOWY, BRIGHTRED, TUBULAR BLOSSOMS ARISE IN SPRING AND SUMMER ON A 2-3-TALL BLOOM STALK FROM A BASAL ROSETTE OF GRAY GREEN LEAVES. PROVIDE GOOD DRAINAGE FORTHIS ONE, AND WATER SPARINGLY IN SUMMER PARTICULARLY NICE ON SLOPES OR IN ROCK GARDENS WHERE IT CAN GETTHE DRAINAGE IT NEEDS WHILE THE VERTICALNESS OF ITS BLOSSOMS SPILLS FORTH IN A BRIGHT, FESTIVE SPRAY REMINISCENT OF, WELL, FIRECRACKERS.
