
LEWIS MOCK ORANGE PHILADELPHUS LEWISH



THE SWEETLY SCENTED 2" BLOSSOMS OF LEWIS MOCK ORANGE, ALSO COMMONLY REFERRED TO AS WILD MOCK ORANGE, ARE ONE OF THE JOYS OF EARLY SUMMER ONE CALIFORNIA'S NATIVE SHRUBS THAT THRNES IN COMPOSTENRICHED GARDEN SOIL, IT CAN REACH 6-8 (OCCASIONALLY 10!) TALL AND WIDE WHERE HAPPY. PLANTIN MORNING SUN OR A PARTIALLY SHADED LOCATION, BUT BE SURE TO PLANTIT WHERE THE DELIGHTFUL FRAGRANCE OF THE BLOSSOMS WILL BE ENJOYED! THE WHATE BLOOMS, THE SCENT OF WHICH IS OFTEN COMPARED TO THE SCENT OF HONEY AND CTRUS, PROVIDE NEEDED FODDER FOR BEES AND ATTRACT THEM AT A TIME WHEN MANY FRUIT AND VEGETABLE PLANTS SETTING FLOWER THOUGHTOLERANT OF DROUGHT, IT IS HAPPIEST WITH REGULAR MOISTURE.
