
GOLDSTURM BLACK-EYED SUSAN

BEGINNING IN MIDSUMMER, THE-TWO-INCH GOLDEN DAISIES WITH CENTRAL CONES OF NEARLY BLACK COVER A 2-3'MOUND, SPILLING LUXURIANTLY OUT OF GARDEN BEDS AND BORDERS, REMINDING US, EVEN IN THE HOTDAYS OF AUGUST, THAT FALL IS ON THE WAY. PAIR WITH LATE BLOOMING GRASSES AND CALIFORNIA FUCHSIA FOR A LOVELY AUTUMN DISPLAY. GREAT FOR CUT FLOWERS!
