RUMEX SANGUINEUS

THIS BEAUTIFUL SORREL IS PERENNIAL AND EDIBLE! USE YOUNG LEAVES IN SALADS TO ADD A TART FLAVOR OR SAUTÉED OR STEAMED MUCH AS YOU WOULD CHARD OR SPINACH. TOLERANT OF SUMMER HEAT, IT KEEPS GOING WHEN MANY GREENS PLANTS FADE OUT. GORGEOUS IN MIXED CONTAINERS AND FLOWER BEDS, AS WELL! TO HARVEST INDIVIDUAL YOUNG LEAVES, CUT THEM 2" FROM THE BASE OF THE PLANT, AND COME BACK LATER FOR MORE! WHEN A BLOOM STALK APPEARS, YOU CAN CUT IT BACK TO KEEP THE PLANT FOCUSED ON PRODUCING THE EVERGREEN LEAVES, OR ALLOW IT TO SELF-SOW GENEROUSLY FOR MORE PLANTS. CLAY TOLERANT AND EASY TO GROW IN MOIST, FERTILE SOIL.
