CLARY SAGE HAS BEEN CULTIVATED FOR CENTURIES AND HAS MANY USES, FROM FLAVORING FOR WINE TO INCENSE TO TTS PURPORTED MEDICINAL USE IN SLOWING THE AGING PROCESS. CLASSICALLY KNOWN AS A BIENNIAL, THIS CULTIVAR NOT ONLY HAS STRIKING WHITE FLOWERS, BUT IS FAR MORE STRONGLY PERENNIAL THAN THE SPECIES. THE CANDELABRA OF GREEN-BRACTED WHITE FLOWERS REACHES 3"IN HEIGHT IN SUMMER. GNING RISE FROM A BASAL ROSETTE OF LARGE GRAY-GREEN LEAVES. ADDING ARCHITECTURAL PRESENCE TO THE HERB GARDEN AND BEYOND, THIS ONE IS A PIECE OF HISTORY. THIS VARIETY IS NOT OFTEN SEEN BUT WARRANTS PLANTING MORE.
