BUTCOME SUMMER, THE SUNSHINE BECOMES APPARENT ONCE MORE, CLEAR AS A CLEAR JUNE DAY. THIS GROUNDCOVER SUCCULENT WILL GLADLY FILL SPACES WHERE LITTLE ELSE WILL GROW, REQUIRING LITTLE OF THOSE WHO GROW IT. DROUGHT AND HEATTOLERANT, BUT ALSO TOLERANT OF REGULAR WATERING, ALLOWING IT TO TAKE A "SPILLER" ROLE IN MIXED CONTAINER PLANTINGS, WHERE ITTRAILS NICELY (AND WILL LIKELY OUTLIVE ITS ROOMMATES!) TO 3-6"INCHES HIGH AND SPREADING.
