NO STRANGER TO THE COLD, $\pi$ SHRUGS OFF WINTEREFFORTLESSLY, DURING WHICH ITS SUCCULENT STEMS TURN A BRIGHT, FESTIVE RED. A MAT-FORMER, TI REACHES ONLY ABOUT 6" HIGH, TRAILING AND ROOTNG
AS TTGOES. ITS UNUSUAL BLOSSOMS EMERGE YELLOW AND FADE TO PINK AND ARE QUITE PRETTY. DROUGHT TOLERANT AS SUCCULENTS ARE, BE SURE TO PROVIDE TTWHTH QUICKDRAINING SOIL (THINK GRAVELLY!)
