NATIVE TO MOUNTAINOUS AREAS OF CALIFORNIA, THIS LITTLE SUCCULENT GLADLY FILLS CRACKS IN ROCK WALLS AND OTHER TIGHT, SEEMINGLY INHOSPITABLE PLACES. THE TINY EVERGREEN ROSETTES TURN LOVELY SUBTLE REDDISH HUES IN THE WINTER, FOLLOWED BY SPLASHY BEE AND BUTTERFLY ATTRACTING YELLOW FLOWERS IN SPRING. FULLY HARDY TO THE FROST, FEEL FREE-TO LET IT FORM A GROUND COVER IN AREAS WITH NO FOOTTRAFFIC. DROUGHT-TOLERANT SUCCULENTS LIKE THIS ONE PREFER TO DRY OUT BETWEEN WATERING, OR JUST DON'T WATER AND LET IT SURVICE ON RAINFALL ALONE. ADORABLE!
