CAUCASIAN GERMANDER TEUCRIUM HYRCANICUM "PURPLETAILS'

> PURPLETAILS IS A FITTING NAME FORTHIS LONG BLOOMING GERMANDER THE LONG FLOWER SPIKES (PURPLE, OF COURSE) ARE HELD UPRIGHT AND SLEEK LIKE A CAT'S TAIL. STUDDED UP AND DOWN THEIR LENGTH WITH SMALL, RED-PURPLE BLOSSOMS OPENING UPWARD ALONG THE SPIKE FROM TINY GREENISH BUDS, THE TAILS EVEN HAVE A RATHER "FUZZY" APPEARANCE. TO 2 1/2'HIGH BY 2'WIDE WITH SAGE-LIKE LEAVES, THIS PERENNIAL WILL TAKE THE PLACE OF THE MORE DEMANDING VERONICAS, CONTRIBUTING THE VERTICALNESS THE VERONICAS ARE KNOWN FOR AND THE DROUGHT TOLERANCE AND DEER RESISTANCE THE GERMANDERS ARE KNOWN FOR NICE AS A CUT FLOWER AND NICE TO THE POLLINATORS AS WELL. SELF SOWS, SO REMOVE SPENT FLOWERS IF MORE PLANTS ARE UNDESIRABLE. THOUGH WE CAN'T SEE WHY THEY WOULD BE!
