
CHASTETREE

THE LILAC FLOWERS, OF PARTICULAR INTEREST TO BUTTERFLIES, APPEAR IN SUMMER AND WILL CONTINUE INTO FALL IF SPENT FLOWERS ARE REMOVED. CHASTE TREE HAS A LONG HISTORY OF CULTIVATION AS A MEDICINAL, AS IS STILL USED TODAY FOR TTS HORMONE REGULATING PROPERTIES. LOVELY AS A LIMBED UP, MULTI-TRUNKED TREE.
