EMERALD CARPET MANZANITA IS WELLKNOWN AS AN EASY, EVERGREEN GROUNDCOVER THAT BEARS WHITE-TO-PINK BEE FEEDING BLOSSOMS IN SPRING. CALIFORNIA NATIVE MANZANITAS CAN SOMETIMES BE DIFFICULT TO CULTIVATE, BUT THIS ONE, DUE TO ITS EASY GOING NATURE, HAS BECOME WIDE SPREAD IN ITS USAGE. FAST GROWING (FOR A MANZANITA), IT SPREADS TO FORM A DENSE, TRAILING CARPET REACHING 1' HIGH BY ABOUT 6' WIDE. BORN OF 2 COASTAL SPECIES, IT DOES APPRECIATE OCCASIONAL WATER DURING HOT SUMMERS INLAND. TOLERATES FULL SUN, BUT IS BEST GROWN IN LIGHT AFTERNOON SHADE IN HOT CLIMATES. GIVE GOOD DRAINAGE.
