HOWARD MCMINN MANZANITA MAY BE THE MOST ADAPTABLE OF ALL THE LARGE MANZANITAS. THIS CALIFORNIA NATIVE EVERGREEN SHRUB WORKS WELL IN MANY PLANTING SITUATIONS. LOVELY IN WINTER TO EARLY SPRING WHEN THE PINK BLOSSOMS APPEAR IN GREAT NUMBERS, FEEDING POLLINATORS WHEN LITTLE ELSE IS IN BLOOM. MAY BE HEDGED, SHEARED, OR LEFT IN ITS BEAUTIFUL NATURAL FORM, IN WHICH IT WILL REACH AROUND 6-7' IN HEIGHT AND DIAMETER WITH ITS CINNAMON-HUED BARK, IT MAKES A LOVELY SMALL TREE WHEN LIMBED UP! UNLIKE MANY OF ITS MANZANITA RELATIVES, HOWARD MCMINN TOLERATES A WIDE RANGE OF SOIL TYPES, INCLUDING CLAY, AND WATERING REGIMES RANGING FROM REGULAR TO NONE. DROUGHT-TOLERANT, EASY TO GROW, AND PERFECT FOR FOOTHILLS LANDSCAPES.
