

PACIFIC MIST MANZANITA

ARCTOSTAPHYLOS x 'PACIFIC MIST'



ONE OF THE FASTER GROWING OF CALIFORNIA'S MANZANITAS, PACIFIC MIST IS AN EXOTIC-LOOKING GROUNDCOVER MANZANITA GROWING TO 2' TALL BY 6-8' ACROSS AND IS EASILY PRUNED TO FIT SMALLER SPACES. THIS NATIVE EVERGREEN SHRUB HAS GRAY GREEN FOLIAGE THAT EMERGES RED TO PINK, AND ESPECIALLY SO IN COOLER WEATHER THE URN-SHAPED FLOWERS IN LATE WINTER TO EARLY SPRING ARE SMALL, BUT PROVIDE A TIMELY SOURCE OF NECTAR FOR POLLINATORS AT A TIME WHEN FOOD IS SCARCE. TOLERANT OF DROUGHT, DRY SEMI-SHADE, AND BOTH SANDY AND HEAVY SOILS, IT IS A RELIABLE PLANT IN MANY AREAS. GREAT ON BANKS FOR EROSION CONTROL, TUMBLING OVER WALLS, AND CASCADING AROUND BOULDERS. TRY THE PRETTY NEW GROWTH AS GREENERY IN YOUR CUT FLOWER BOUQUETS!
