## ARMERIA MARITIMA 'ALBA'



JUST LIKE ITS NON-IDENTICAL TWIN PINK SEA THRIFT, THIS WHITE-FLOWERED FORM FORMS A GREEN, GRASSY TUFT OF EVERGREEN FOLIAGE WHICH IS SUDDENLY TOPPED BY LITTLE ORBS OF BLOSSOMS THAT HOVER ABOVE IT ON TALL STEMS. DELICATE ENOUGH FOR ANY FAIRY'S WEDDING, THIS MEMBER OF THE LILY FAMILY IS ACTUALLY A TOUGH NATIVE OF OUR RUGGED COASTLINES, WHERE IT ENDURES DROUGHT AND POOR SOIL. ATTRACTIVE TO BUTTERFLIES, THE BLOSSOMS CAN APPEAR MOST ANYTIME, BUT ARE HEAVIEST IN SPRING AND EARLY SUMMER. NICE PLANTED IN MASSES, ALONG PATHWAYS, AND AMONG OTHER PERENNIALS THAT BENEFIT FROM THEIR SPARKLE. REACHES 1' HIGH IN BLOOM.
