BORAGO OFFICINALIS



A TRADITIONAL ANNUAL HERB, BORAGE HAS TASTY YOUNG LEAVES WHICH HAVE A FLAVOR OFTEN COMPARED TO CUCUMBER AND CAN BE EATEN IN SALADS. AND EVEN IF THEY WERE NOT SWEET AND EDIBLE, THE BEAUTIFUL BLUE BLOSSOMS, QUITE ATTRACTIVE TO BEES, MAKE BORAGE WORTHY OF A SPOT IN YOUR GARDEN. FOR SOMETHING UNUSUAL, USE THEM AS DECORATIONS FOR CAKES OR CONFECTIONS. SELF SOWS READILY, SO IF YOU PLANT ONE YOU WILL LIKELY HAVE MORE IN THE YEARS TO COME. 1-3' TALL X 14" WIDE.
