GIANT RED MUSTARD ADDS DRAMA TO THE COOL SEASON POTAGER. ITS LARGE, DARK PLUM-COLOR-OVER-GREEN LEAVES MAKE A PUNGENT, SPICY ADDITION TO ASIAN DISHES. TRY THEM SLICED AND LIGHTLY SAUTÉED, OR WILTED, WITH GARLIC AS GARNISH FOR SOUPS AND STEWS TO ADD A BRIGHT, PEPPERY FLAVOR. GIANT RED MUSTARD IS A BEAUTIFUL PLANT WITH FOLDS OF LARGE LEAVES THAT ARE PRETTY IN MIXED CONTAINERS AND BEAUTIFUL IN THE GARDEN. IT GROWS WELL THROUGH THE COOL MONTHS OF FALL AND EARLY SPRING, BUT WILL BOLT AND GO TO SEED WHEN THE WEATHER TURNS WARM. LET IT FLOWER AND FADE BEFORE REMOVING IT AND IT WILL SELF-SOW, GIVING YOU MORE PLANTS TO WARM YOUR NEXT COOL-SEASON.
