

# BUSH ANEMONE

## CARPENTERIA CALIFORNICA

ENDEMIC TO ONLY THE SOUTHERN FOOTHILLS OF THE SIERRA NEVADA, BUSH ANEMONE IS ONE OF CALIFORNIA'S MOST RARE NATIVE SHRUBS IN THE WILD. ITS LUSH, DARK GREEN FOLIAGE AND CLUSTERED 2" SCENTED WHITE BLOSSOMS COMPLETELY STAND APART FROM MOST FOOTHILLS NATIVES. UNBEATABLE FOR WOODLAND GARDENS, BUT REFINED ENOUGH EVEN FOR FORMAL SETTINGS, BUSH ANEMONE NEEDS VERY LITTLE WATER ONCE ESTABLISHED. A DENIZEN OF WOODLAND SETTINGS IN NATURE, IT APPRECIATES A LAYER OF ORGANIC MULCH OVER ITS ROOT ZONE. THE EVERGREEN, UPRIGHT FORM GENERALLY REACHES AROUND 6' TALL AND 3' ACROSS AND IS PARTICULARLY NICE IN GROUPS IN THE DAPPLED SHADE NEAR LARGE TREES. ONE OF OUR ALL TIME FAVORITES!
