

WHITE JUPITER'S BEARD

CENTRANTHUS RUBER 'ALBUS'

BLOOMING OVER A LONG PERIOD STARTING IN EARLY SUMMER, THIS JUPITER'S BEARD DIFFERS FROM THE MORE COMMON RED FORM IN THAT ITS FLOWERS ARE WHITE. A LOVELY ACCENT, IT WILL GROW QUICKLY TO FILL A 3X3' SPACE EACH SEASON. STAYING MORE OR LESS EVERGREEN, ANY SPENT STALKS CAN BE CUT TO THE GROUND TO ALLOW FRESH ONES TO EMERGE. RESEEDS! PLANT THIS AND YOU WILL HAVE MORE, I GUARANTEE IT. IF YOU WANT TO MOVE THEM, DIG THEM EARLY BEFORE THE TUBEROUS ROOTS THAT MAKE THE PLANT SO DROUGHT-TOLERANT HAVE A CHANCE TO DIG TOO DEEP. ATTRACTS BUTTERFLIES WITH ITS SCENTED FLOWERS, WHICH ALSO MAKE GREAT CUT FLOWERS. VERY EASY TO GROW.
