

# MORNING CLOUD CHTALPA X CHTALPA-TASHKENTENSIS 'MORNING CLOUD'



FOR THOSE THAT WANT THEIR DESERT WILLOW TO BE MORE TREE-LIKE THAN SHRUB-LIKE, THE CHTALPAS ARE THE WAY TO GO. AS DROUGHT TOLERANT AS THEIR DESERT WILLOW PARENT, THEY REACH 25-30' RAPIDLY, AS COMPARED TO THE DESERT WILLOW'S 15', WITH A BIT LESS OF A TENDENCY TO BE MULTIPLE-STEMMED. AN INTERGENERIC HYBRID, THEY DO NOT PRODUCE THE SEED PODS THAT BOTH OF THEIR PARENTS (THE DESERT WILLOW AND THE CATALPA) ARE KNOWN FOR, AND INSTEAD CONTINUE PRODUCING BEAUTIFUL, POLLINATOR ATTRACTING BLOSSOMS THROUGHOUT MUCH OF THE SUMMER. MORNING CLOUD IS A WHITE BLOOMING FORM, WITH TUBULAR WHITE BLOOMS WITH PURPLE LINED THROATS TO GUIDE POLLINATORS TO THE NECTAR WITHIN. LOVELY!
