

MOONBEAM COREOPSIS

COREOPSIS VERTICILLATA 'MOONBEAM'

ANOTHER DECEPTIVE PLANT WITH A DELICATE APPEARANCE AND A TOUGH NATURE, 'MOONBEAM' FORMS HUNDREDS OF SOFT YELLOW FLOWERS ATOP AN 18" MOUND OF THREADLIKE FOLIAGE. THE LOOK IS WONDERFULLY AIRY BUT THE PLANT ITSELF IS MUSCULAR; DROUGHT-TOLERANT, DEER RESISTANT (MUCH MORE SO THAN BROAD LEAFED COREOPSIS GRANDIFLORA!), TOLERANT OF POOR SOILS, LONG LIVED, AND A VERY LONG BLOOMER WITH A FLOWER COLOR SO EASY TO COMBINE WITH OTHER COLORS, THIS PLANT IS A WINNER FOR MIXED CONTAINERS OR BORDERS. REMOVE SPENT FLOWERS TO KEEP THE PLANT IN BLOOM AND YOU'LL HAVE A CONTINUOUS BLOOM PERIOD FROM EARLY SUMMER THROUGH FALL
