THOUGH ALWAYS LOVELY, CALIFORNIA NATIVE RED-TWIG DOGWOOD IS A MEDIUM-SIZED SHRUB OF FAIRLY UNASSUMING APPEARANCE, UNTIL THE FALL COLOR APPEARS. THE LEAVES GROW IN INTENSITY UNTIL THEY SETTLE ON A DISTINCT RED BEFORE DROPPING FOR THE WINTER THEN, IN THE MIDST OF THE COLORLESSNESS OF WINTER, THE TWIGS, A RICH RED ON YOUNGER STEMS, FAIRLY GLOW OUT OF THE GLOOM. CUTTING REGULARLY WILL KEEP THE TWIGS YOUNG AND GLOWING AT THEIR BRIGHTEST. BRING SOME INDOORS FOR A BEAUTIFUL HOLIDAY DECORATION! ADAPTABLE TO MANY SOILS (INCLUDING CLAY!), RED-TWIG DOGWOOD PREFERENCES TO BE KEPT MOIST. TO 9' HIGH.
