


FAWN LILY ERYTHRONIUM 'PAGODA'

THE DELIGHT OF SPRINGTIME WILDFLOWER SEEKERS, THE FAWN LILY (OR TROUT LILY, OR DOG TOOTH VIOLET) IS A CALIFORNIA NATIVE BULB THAT FORMS COLONIES OF BROAD-LEAFED SPRINGTIME EPHEMERALS IN OPEN WOODLANDS AND MEADOWS. THE NODDING, PALE SULFUR COLORED BLOSSOMS ARE GORGEOUS AND GRACEFUL IN THE FILTERED SUNLIGHT, AND BRIGHTEN THE SHADOWEST OF SPOTS. 'PAGODA' IS A HYBRID BETWEEN OUR OWN ERYTHRONIUM TUOLUMNENSE (ENDEMIC TO TUOLUMNE COUNTY AND LISTED AS RARE AND ENDANGERED) AND ERYTHRONIUM CALIFORNICUM, SELECTED FOR ITS VIGOR AND EASE OF CULTURE. WHERE HAPPY, IN MOIST, ORGANIC SOIL, IT WILL SPREAD RAPIDLY, BECOMING A LARGER DISPLAY YEAR AFTER YEAR. DEER RESISTANT AND TOLERANT OF DROUGHT DUE TO SUMMER DORMANCY.
