TOTALLY DEER RESISTANT, YOU CAN TUCK THEM ALL OVER YOUR GARDEN, EVEN UNDER NATIVE OAKS, WHERE THEIR LOW WATER NEEDS COME IN QUITE HANDY. TRULY GORGEOUS CALIFORNIA WILDFLOWERS!
