WITH DARK PURPLE BLOOMS APPEARING THROUGHOUT THE SUMMER AND INTO FALL, THE POLLINATOR BELOVED, FRAGRANT FLORAL DISPLAY IS ONE OF THE BEST. CONSIDERED A FRENCH LAVENDER, IT IS ACTUALLY A LUCKY CROSS BETWEEN WOOLY LAVENDER AND FRENCH, WHICH GIVES IT A NICE, PUFFY-LEAVED, SILVERY APPEARANCE IN ADDITION TO GREAT HEAT TOLERANCE. DEER RESISTANT, EVERGREEN, AND FAST GROWING, THIS BEAUTIFUL GARDEN LAVENDER WILL REACH 2-3' HIGH AND 3-4' ACROSS. PROVIDE GOOD DRAINAGE AND SHELTER FROM THE WORST OF WINTER'S WEATHER AT HIGHER ELEVATIONS.
