

GROSSO LAVENDER

LAVANDULA X INTERMEDIA 'GROSSO'



THE CLASSIC LAVENDER GROWN FOR PRODUCTION: GROSSO IS RICH WITH HEAVILY PERFUMED BLOSSOMS READY TO SCENT YOUR ROOMS. NOT AT ALL "GROSS" (ACTUALLY ONE OF THE MOST BEAUTIFUL PLANTS IN THE GARDEN), THE NAME ACTUALLY MEANS LARGE AND ROBUST IN ITALIAN, WHICH SUITS THIS PLANT TO A TEE. THIS IS A BIG LAVENDER, REACHING 3 1/2' TALL AND WIDE IN BLOOM. DROUGHT TOLERANT AND DEER RESISTANT. EASY TO GROW; JUST GIVE IT GOOD DRAINAGE, DON'T OVER WATER, PLANT IT A BIT HIGH WITH ITS CROWN SLIGHTLY ABOVE THE SURROUNDING GRADE, AND CUT BACK AFTER THE BLOOMS FADE (IN FALL) TO A 18" HUMMOCK. MULCHING WITH GRAVEL AT THE BASE OF THE PLANT HELPS THE CROWN TO DRY QUICKER, KEEPING IT HAPPY AND HEALTHY. ATTRACTS BEES.
