LEWISIA COTYLEDON 'SUNSET STRAIN'



A BELOVED PERENNIAL WILDFLOWER OF THE PACIFIC NORTHWEST, THE SPRING BLOSSOMS OF SUNSET STRAIN LEWISIA VARY FROM SHADES OF APRICOT TO YELLOW TO BOLDEST MAGENTA. NATIVE TO NORTHERN CALIFORNIA AND OREGON, IT PREFERS A MORE REGULAR WATERING REGIME THAN MOST SUCCULENTS, BUT NEEDS QUICK DRAINING, GRITTY SOIL TO THRIVE. LOVELY IN POTS OR ROCK GARDENS, IT IS TRULY A THING OF BEAUTY PLANTED IN THE CRACKS OF A ROCK WALL WHERE ITS DEEP TAP ROOT WILL ANCHOR THE PLANT AND ITS BEAUTIFUL BLOOMS WILL RECEIVE THE FRAME THAT THEY DESERVE. WITH TIME, THE 5" ROSETTES FORM A GOOD SIZE CLUMP, CONTRIBUTING NICE TEXTURE EVEN WHEN OUT OF BLOOM. TRULY A THING OF DELICATE BEAUTY.
