

MOUNTAIN TWINBERRY

A HIGH MOUNTAIN TO UPPER-MID ELEVATION SHRUB NATIVE TO THE SIERRA NEVADA, MOUNTAIN TWINBERRY IS ALSO KNOWN AS WEDDED TWINBERRY FOR THE BRIGHT RED PAIRS OF BERRIES (JOINED AT THE HIP) IT PRODUCES IN LATE SUMMER, AND AS PURPLE FLOWER HONEYSUCKLE FOR ITS DARK MAROON, TINY BLOSSOMS. A TINY SHRUB REACHING 2-3' HIGH BY 3-5' WIDE, IT IS SUITABLE FOR MOIST SHADY AREAS OF THE GARDEN, WHERE IT IS ATTRACTIVE TO POLLINATORS. THE TINY BLOSSOMS ARE A TREAT FOR FLOWER HUNTERS, AS THEY OFTEN GO MISSED DUE TO THEIR ULTRA PETITE SIZE. A CLOSE LOOK REVEALS THEIR BEAUTY, DARK RED WITH PROTRUDING STAMENS CARRYING POLLEN AND INVITING NATIVE BEES FOR A SIP OF NECTAR
