WHAT A FLOWER COLOR! LONG BLOOMING BEAUJOLAIS IS VERY ATTRACTIVE TO BUTTERFLIES AND MAKES AN EXCELLENT CUT FLOWER TOLERANT OF HEAVY SOILS, EVEN THOSE THAT STAY WET, THIS LOOSESTRIFE IS NOT TO BE CONFUSED WITH PURPLE LOOSESTRIFE (LYTHRUM SALICARIA) AND DOES NOT HAVE THAT PLANT'S INVASIVE QUALITIES. INSTEAD, IT FORMS A SLOWLY SPREADING CLUMP, IDEAL FOR PLANTING NEAR WATER FEATURES OR STREAMS. AND AS IF THE SUMMER LONG BLOOM TIME OF ELEGANT, WINE COLORED FLOWERS WEREN'T ENOUGH, THE SILVERY FOLIAGE LOOKS LOVELY IN THE SHADY AREAS THIS PLANT PREFERS. GORGEOUS!
