HIGHLY ATTRACTIVE TO BUTTERFLIES AND OTHER POLLINATORS, MOUNTAIN PENNYROYAL'S SHARP MINTY FRAGRANCE IS FAMILIAR TO ALL WHO ENJOY HIKING AT HIGH ELEVATIONS. A TOUGH CALIFORNIA NATIVE, IT GROWS HAPPILY ON POOR SOILS WITH LITTLE WATER, FORMING A 14" HIGH AND 2' WIDE MOUND OF EVERGREEN LEAVES. BOTH THE PUNGENT LEAVES AND THE LAVENDER BLOSSOMS CAN BE USED TO MAKE AN INVIGORATING TEA, AND MAKE A FLAVORFUL ADDITION TO HERBAL TEA BLENDS. VERY RESISTANT TO DEER, PLANT IT AMONG OTHER ROCK GARDEN PERENNIALS TO DISCOURAGE BROWSING. PROVIDE GOOD WINTER DRAINAGE AND CUT BACK AFTER BLOOM TO ENCOURAGE REBLOOM.
