

# DEER GRASS

## MUHLENBERGIA RIGENS

CALIFORNIA NATIVE DEER GRASS IS A SIZEABLE CLUMP-FORMER REACHING 3' HIGH BY ABOUT 5' ACROSS, IT IS A NICE, SOFT GREEN HUMMOCK OUT OF WHICH ARISE THE 5' TALL, STRAIGHT AS AN ARROW SEED HEADS IN SUMMER DRAMATIC AS A SPECIMEN AND LOVELY AS A SOFT, LUMPY, MASS PLANTING, IT IS ONE OF THE MOST DROUGHT AND DEER RESISTANT GRASSES GOING. USE TO COVER HARD TO PLANT SLOPES TO STABILIZE SOIL, AS A BACKGROUND PLANTING IN NATIVE OR IRRIGATION FREE LANDSCAPES, OR, REALLY, ANYPLACE IN YOUR GARDEN. ITS SMOOTH, ROUNDED FORM AND FINE-TEXTURE WILL ADD A CALMING INFLUENCE AND PROVIDE A FOIL FOR BUSIER BLOOMING PLANTS. SEMI-EVERGREEN CLUMPS CAN BE CUT BACK IN WINTER OR COMBED WITH A RAKE TO REMOVE OLD BLADES. SELF-SOWS.
