CATMINT HAS BECOME ALMOST UBIQUITOUS FOR ITS EASE OF CULTIVATION, LOVELY SCENT, BEAUTIFUL LAVENDER BLUE FLOWERS, AND RESISTANCE TO BOTH DEER AND DROUGHT. A PROLIFIC BLOOMER, CATMINT CAN BE CUT BACK HARD A FEW TIMES A SEASON TO HELP IT CONTINUE TO PRODUCE THE MULTITUDES OF BLOOMS FOR WHICH IT IS FAMOUS. TOUGH AND EASY TO GROW, IT WILL OCCUPY A SPACE OF ABOUT 21/2X3' WHEN FULLY GROWN. ATTRACTIVE TO BUTTERFLIES, BEES, AND OCCASIONALLY CATS, OF WHICH AT LEAST ONE OF OURS SEEMS TO PARTICULARLY ENJOY THE MINTY FRAGRANCE OF THE PLANT WHEN HE ROLLS AROUND IN IT LUXURIANTLY, TAKING ADVANTAGE OF ITS FLEA REPELLING PROPERTIES.
