GROWN AS AN ORNAMENTAL FOR ITS LOVELY WANDS OF PURPLE FLOWERS THAT APPEAR IN MID-TO LATE SUMMER, HOPLEY'S PURPLE IS A LOVELY, AROMATIC ADDITION TO YOUR GARDEN. THE BLOSSOMS ARE NOT ONLY ATTRACTIVE TO US; THEY ARE ALSO HIGHLY ATTRACTIVE TO BUTTERFLIES AND BENEFICIAL INSECTS. WITH ITS TOUGH NATURE, IT IS DROUGHT-TOLERANT AND EASILY GROWN IN ALL BUT COMPLETELY SOGGY SOIL. REACHING 2X3' IN BLOOM, IT IS A FREE SPIRITED MOUND OF DELICATE FOLIAGE AND FLOWERS WHICH REMAINS PRETTY OVER A LONG PERIOD. AROMATIC, BUT NOT ENOUGH TO BE CONSIDERED CULINARY, THE LEAVES AND FLOWERS BOTH CAN BE ADDED TO POTPOURRIS OR USED AS A MILD SEASONING. GREAT AS A CUT FLOWER!
