

# BRIDGE PENSTEMON

## PENSTEMON ROSTRIFLORUS



ILLCITING OOHS AND AHS FROM TRAVELERS IN HIGH ELEVATION AREAS, BRIDGE PENSTEMON BURSTS INTO SEARING RED BLOOM IN MID-SUMMER. NATURALLY OCCURRING IN VERY TOUGH PLACES, THIS CALIFORNIA NATIVE WILDFLOWER REACHES AN ALMOST SHRUB-LIKE FORM AT 2-3' TALL AND WIDE. LONG-LIVED (UNUSUAL FOR A PENSTEMON!) AND DROUGHT-TOLERANT, THIS MOUNTAIN DWELLER WON'T ASK FOR MUCH, BUT GIVES SO MUCH IN RETURN! ALSO KNOWN AS MOUNTAIN FOUNTAINS, THE BLOSSOMS ATTRACT HUMMINGBIRDS AND WILL KEEP COMING FROM SUMMER TO FALL WITH A LITTLE SUMMER WATER. PROVIDE GOOD DRAINAGE, SOME SPACE FOR IT TO GROW, AND SIT BACK AND WATCH THE SHOW.
