

BEE'S BLISS SAGE



SALVIA 'BEE'S BLISS'



THIS NATURAL HYBRID OF CALIFORNIA NATIVE SAGE SPECIES IS A KEEPER FORMING A CREEPING MATEVENTUALLY REACHING 6+' ACROSS AND ONLY 2'TALL, IT IS GREAT FOR FILLING HOT, DRY SPACES WHERE ONCE ONLY WEEDS GREW. THE AROMATIC FOLIAGE IS VERY RESISTANT TO BROWSING DEER, WHILE THE PRETTY BLOSSOMS THAT RISE ABOVE THE EVERGREEN FOLIAGE IN SPRING ARE HEAVILY VISITED BY BEES AND OTHER POLLINATORS. THE CREEPING FORM ALLOWS IT TO SPREAD AMONG ROCK OUTCROPPINGS AND OVER BANKS. QUITE DROUGHT-TOLERANT, IT REQUIRES VERY LITTLE SUPPLEMENTAL WATER ONCE ESTABLISHED, FLOURISHING WITH ONLY A FEW DEEP WATERING OVER THE SUMMER MONTHS. THOUGH NOT RECOMMENDED FOR ELEVATIONS ABOVE 4000', IT'S A VERY NICE PLANT FOR THE LOWER FOOTHILLS AREAS!
