WITH EDIBLE YOUNG LEAVES THAT TASTE SOMETHING OF CUCUMBER OR MELON, SALAD BURNET IS A TASTY ADDITION TO MIXED GREENS SALADS AND SANDWICHES. GROWN SINCE ELIZABETHAN TIMES, THIS PERENNIAL EDIBLE THRIVES IN SUN OR PART SHADE AND HAS DELIGHTFUL, THIMBLE-SHAPED PINK FLOWERS TO BOOT. ITS TASTY, LACY LEAVES ARE EVERGREEN AND ITS PRETTY PINK FLOWERS ARE ATTRACTIVE TO BEES. TRY THIS ONE IN YOUR POTAGER OR HERB GARDEN FOR A TASTY, PRETTY PLANT THAT COMES BACK YEAR AFTER YEAR SELF-SOWS. TO 1' TALL.
