SEDUM RUPESTRE 'ANGELINA'



ANOTHER MEMBER OF THE VERY LARGE SEDUM CLAN. ANGELINA HAS BECOME WELL KNOWN FOR HER EASE OF CULTURE AND QUICKLY SPREADING HABIT. THE GLOWING GOLDEN FOLIAGE TAKES ON PINK TO RED TONES IN THE COOL WEATHER OF WINTER, SOMETIMES LEADING IT TO APPEAR BEAUTIFULLY APRICOT IN HUE. BUT COME SUMMER, THE SUNSHINE BECOMES APPARENT ONCE MORE, CLEAR AS A CLEAR JUNE DAY. THIS GROUND COVER SUCCULENT WILL GLADLY FILL SPACES WHERE LITTLE ELSE WILL GROW, REQUIRING LITTLE OF THOSE WHO GROW IT. DROUGHT AND HEAT TOLERANT, BUT ALSO TOLERANT OF REGULAR WATERING, ALLOWING IT TO TAKE A "SPILLER" ROLE IN MIXED CONTAINER PLANTINGS, WHERE IT TRAILS NICELY (AND WILL LIKELY OUTLINE ITS ROOMMATES!) TO 3-6" INCHES HIGH AND SPREADING.
