

CORSICAN STONECROP

SEDUM DASYPHYLLUM 'MAJOR'



THIS DIMINUTIVE SUCCULENT FORMS A PEBBLY, DROUGHT-TOLERANT GROUND COVER FOR THOSE LITTLE WATERED AREAS. CREEPING AMONG ROCKS OR OTHER PLANTS, ITS DELIGHTFUL TEXTURE AND SILVER BLUE COLOR PROVIDES A GREAT ACCENT. TRY IT INTERPLANTED WITH TUFTS OF BLUE FESCUE AND THE LARGER LEAVED SEDUM SIEBOLDII (OCTOBER DAPHNE) FOR A COOL, MONOCHROMATIC QUILT OF TEXTURAL CONTRAST. IN EARLY SUMMER,

CORSICAN STONECROP BURSTS FORTH WITH TINY, DELICATE STARRY WHITE FLOWERS. AS WITH ALL STONECROPS, THIS ONE ASKS FOR GOOD DRAINAGE AND NOT A WHOLE LOT MORE. ADORABLE!
