


OCTOBER DAPHNE

SEDUM SIEBOLDII



A PERFECTLY LOVELY PERENNIAL, OCTOBER DAPHNE HAS GORGEOUS SILVERY BLUE, SCALLOPED LEAVES, EACH WITH ITS OWN PINK MARGIN, AND A LOVELY HABIT. TRAILING OUT FROM A CENTRAL POINT TO 14" WIDE, IT CREATES A FLAT, CIRCULAR SILHOUETTE TO 4" HIGH. THE PINK FLOWERS ARE BELOVED BY BUTTERFLIES AND APPEAR IN SEPTEMBER OR OCTOBER, JUST AS THE ENTIRE PLANT BEGINS TO TURN ANY MANNER OF LOVELY PINK SHADES DUE TO THE ONSET OF COLD WEATHER. DROUGHT-TOLERANT LIKE ALL SEDUMS, GIVE THIS ONE GOOD DRAINAGE AND LET IT DRY OUT BEFORE WATERING AGAIN.
