

MISTY Highbush Blueberry



VACCINIUM CORYMBOSUM 'MISTY'

ONE OF THE MOST VIGOROUS OF THE SOUTHERN Highbush BLUEBERRY VARIETIES, 'MISTY' IS A HEAVY PRODUCER OF LARGE, EARLY SEASON FRUIT. WITH A LOW WINTER CHILL REQUIREMENT (300 HOURS), IT IS SUITABLE FOR GROWING IN THE WARMER PARTS OF THE STATE, BUT DOES FINE AS FAR NORTH AS ZONE 5. MORE HEAT TOLERANT THAN NORTHERN VARIETIES, IT IS A GOOD CHOICE IN HOT SUMMER AREAS SUCH AS OURS. ITS FAST GROWTH AND HIGH QUALITY FRUIT MAKE IT A FAVORITE AMONG CALIFORNIA GARDENERS ACROSS THE STATE. 'MISTY' IS AN ATTRACTIVE PLANT, REACHING 4-6' HIGH AND WIDE, AND MAKES A GREAT CONTAINER SPECIMEN (THINK LARGE CONTAINER) WHERE THE SOIL CAN BE KEPT AS ACIDIC AS BLUEBERRIES PREFER (PH 4-5) WITHOUT AFFECTING OTHER GARDEN PLANTS. SELF FERTILE, BUT PRODUCTION IS INCREASED WHEN PLANTED WITH OTHER VARIETIES.
